College where our students enjoyed the fun of the Didjeribone Show. Whilst incorporating a true cultural experience, the performance explored tradition through







Chess at St. Mary's



like to make a Tassel at lunchtimes on Tuesdays over 3 to 4 weeks depending on the level of interest. I'm looking forward to making my tassel!


Coding Club starting soon

You would need to commit to the eight weeks of sessions offered now in term 3 and pay \$21.00 in advance to contribute to the cost of running the program.


We know that we have children who like to be part of a choir and that is why we are offering these sessions.






